


WORSHIP LEAD JOB DESCRIPTION

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE

Worship Teams

- Planning and coordinating rehearsals for multiple bands.
- Collaborate in preparing and presenting productions, one-off creative items (song, spoken word, dance, drama, etc.)

Development

- The recruiting, onboarding, training and development of musicians and singers.
- Establish a pipeline of musicians from teens onward.

Aware of the overall ministry of LRC and serving together with the team of staff and volunteers to make it happen.

LINE MANAGEMENT
